Thank you for sending us information on the latest proposal for the Witnessing History Education Foundation, Inc. (WHEF). I look forward to seeing the three documentaries you plan to produce on the American Revolution. As with your other projects, these proposed documentaries will vividly bring the conflict to life and assist in preserving that history for a broadcast audience and for the education community through related educational resources.

As the chief content officer of Kentucky Educational Television, a PBS affiliate, I am always seeking content that is representative of our region. KET currently reaches an average of more than 1.9 million viewers across the state of Kentucky and into seven adjacent states as well. These documentaries are sure to appeal to our viewers.

We anticipate that these new documentaries will also be excellent resources for KET to distribute through PBS LearningMedia, the national public media repository of digital educational resources that service more that 19 million users nationwide. Daniel Boone and the Opening of the American West was segmented for use in PBS LearningMedia and has been viewed over 17,800 times in the past two years.

Pending a review of the final program, KET will consider a statewide broadcast of these documentaries. We also feel there will be strong interest in national distribution of the documentaries as well and we're happy to discuss that further when it's appropriate.
